Diplomatic missions of the Host Country have been informed about the above-mentioned meeting. In this context, it is anticipated that the Government of the Host Country will use its good offices to speed up the process of issuance of visas to facilitate such participation.

This confirmation note and a copy of the official information note should be used to support the application for a visa with the host country authorities.

The Government of Brazil shall issue special entry visas (hereinafter referred to as "COP30 Visa"), free of charge, through an official electronic visa portal for COP 30.

Visa processing for COP 30 may take up to ten (10) working days from the date of submission of a complete application via the portal. Notifications regarding the status of the visa application will be sent to the email address provided during the application process. It is therefore imperative that a correct and active email address is provided to ensure timely receipt of visa-related communications.

Participants requiring a visa to enter Brazil are strongly encouraged to apply through the official [electronic visa portal for COP 30](#). As part of the application process, applicants will be required to upload the UNFCCC acknowledgment letter.

The availability, proximity, price and standard of accommodations is the responsibility of the host country at each COP and Participants are urged to book their accommodation for their time at COP 30 as soon as possible. At the registration counter of the conference, participants must provide this document (either printed or from a mobile device) and a personal identification document in the form of a valid passport or a



nationally approved photo identification card. Please note that the details provided to the UNFCCC Secretariat using the Online Registration System (ORS) must match with the identification document.

Nominations can be cancelled or replaced by the nominating DCP at any time. For registration, the UNFCCC Secretariat will use the latest information provided using the ORS.

In the interest of safety and security of all participants and the smooth and efficient conduct of the sessions, the UNFCCC Secretariat reserves the right to deny and/or restrict access to the conference premises, or to request participants to leave the conference premises. The UNFCCC Secretariat shall not be responsible for any expenses incurred by participants who are requested to leave the premises or are refused registration or access to the sessions for which they have been nominated and/or registered as participants.
